CHARGING POLICY

Education Outside School Hours

No charge is made for education provided wholly or mainly outside school hours where this is arranged to fulfil requirements of the National Curriculum or of statutory duties relating to Religious Education.

The Annual Residential School visit must be paid for in **full** by all attending. Payment will be phased over a period of time, essentially dictated by the visiting centre i.e. Robinwood.

Tuition in the Playing of a Musical Instrument

Pupils must agree to meet all the costs of tuition fees.

Education During School Hours

Education is free of charge during school hours. The school will decide which pupils will be given the opportunity to participate without reference to parents' willingness or ability to make voluntary contributions. The school reserves the right to cancel a visit if there is insufficient money to cover costs.

The majority of Parents have agreed to contribute towards the cost of transport for additional swimming instruction. Parents may be invited to provide or pay for materials for use in practical lessons and charged where Parents have indicated a wish to retain the finished object.
