Step 4: To the nearest minute

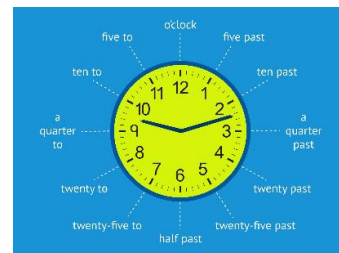
Step 5: Problem solving e.g if the bus leaves at 3pm and the journey takes 25 minutes, what time will it arrive? Etc.
