Here are a few updates and reminders: -

- Session times are 8.55-11.55am for our 15-hour children and 8.55-3.15pm for our 30-hour children. At the beginning of drop off and pick-up times, we will open the gate for you to enter the Early Years yard to drop-off or collect your children with the exception of **11.55am pickup which is at the nursery door and our 2-year-old drop-off at 12.30**. The 2-year-old session time is 12.30-15.30 with drop-off at the side door and pick-up in the EY yard.
- As we spend lots of time outside, it is possible we may become muddy during our activities. If you could please be sure your child has a change of clothes at school and if you have spare wellies, it is much appreciated. Also please apply suncream before school and if reapplication is needed, include a name labeled suncream in your child's bag.
- **PE** will now be taking place on **Friday mornings**.
- Staff members can talk to you briefly at the beginning or end of the session, and we can also arrange a telephone call back to have a proper chat.
