Reading

- Children should be aiming to read several times throughout the week at home. If you or your child could make a note in their reading records at least once a week that would be great for us to see what they are reading and how they are getting on. We will be listening to your child read this week to check which reading level is suitable for them and be sending a new reading book/record home.

Math

- The main math homework focus in Year 4 is times tables and telling the time. All children will be using Timestables.co.uk and encouraged to use this at home too.

- A new reading book.
- A homework book with full explanation of tasks/expectations/hand in requirements.
